- Have shown a commitment to sustainable agriculture, food justice, local and/or organic cuisine, farm-to-table restaurants, agri-tourism, environmental studies, nutrition and health, food science, and/or a related field.
- Are residents of the Mid-Hudson Valley and plan to return to the area after graduating to advance the purpose of the scholarship.

Award: A \$2,000 scholarship will be awarded to a qualified candidate selected by the Rhinebeck Farmers Market scholarship committee.
